FAQ

*How **many** books can I borrow?*

You can borrow two books at one time.

*How **long** can I keep the book for?*

You are allowed to borrow books for **two** weeks.

What happens if I keep the book for longer than two weeks?

You will be sent a **reminder letter** if your books are not returned by their **due date**. If you have **overdue** books, you will not be able to borrow any more **books**, until they are returned.

*What happens if I **lose** a book?*

You will not be expected to **pay** for any resources that you **lose but you will be reminded to look for the book and the loss will be recorded.**
